

Cookie Policy

What are cookies?

Cookies are simply a small piece of data, stored as a text file on your computer whenever you visit a website. There are varying purposes for cookies depending on the type and can last for varying lengths of time.

Can they harm my computer?

In short no, they cannot harm your computer, however depending on the type of cookie, there are other things to consider before determining whether you want to accept or reject them. They are:

First party session cookies which last for the time you are on our site and are essential to your browsing.

Third party cookies in our case are Twitter cookies which connect you, our site and Twitter. You can find out more about these in the table below.

Persistent cookies, which is what most of these cookies are means they don't just stop when you leave our site, they will stay with you for a period of time afterwards.
